

- Praise God for anything that happens, your reaction will teach more than your words.

Don'ts

- (Don't) Be late
- Miss an opportunity to teach a Bible truth
- Miss an evangelistic opportunity.
- Be negative at any time during VBS. Bad attitudes are extremely contagious.
- Let the students decide what to do. That is your job.
- Try to finish all 5 days in one.
- Allow students in the building early.
