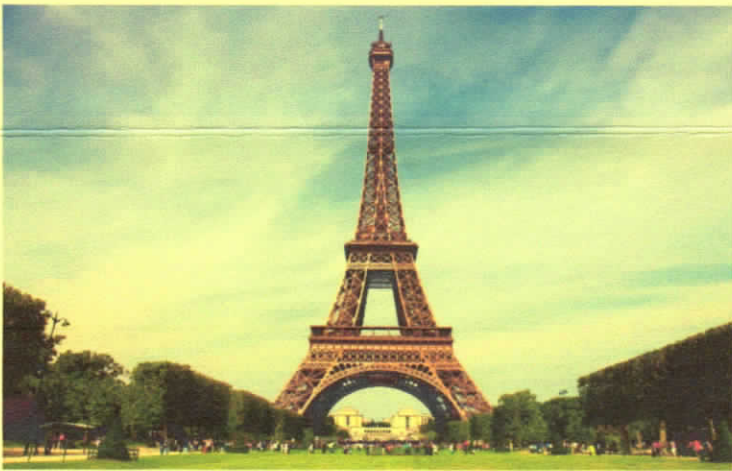

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

THE EIFFEL TOWER

The Eiffel Tower is one of Paris's most visited attractions. Almost seven million individuals visit per year. It was completed 126 years ago on March 31, 1889. The tower is 324 meters tall (including antennas) and weighs 10,100 tons. It is possible to climb to the top, but there are 1,665 steps. Most people take the lift. The lifts travel a combined distance of 103,000 km a year – two and a half times the circumference of the Earth.



THE LOUVRE

The Louvre or the Louvre Museum is one of the world's largest museums and a historic monument in Paris, France. A central landmark of the city, it is located on the Right Bank of the Seine. The Louvre Museum houses the Mona Lisa by Italian artist Leonardo da Vinci. It has been on permanent display at the Louvre Museum since 1797.
