

We strive to provide activities and opportunities to promote the development of readiness skills, self-expression, physical and social/emotional growth. Curriculum is developed following Pre-K standards set for preschoolers in cooperation with New Albany-Plain Local schools.



Our curriculum includes:

Language Arts...enhance & develop letters & reading.

Math & Science...discover the wonders of science & the process of math.

Social Studies...seasons, the community, transportation, holidays, animals etc.

Bible lessons...prayers, Bible stories & know God can be a part of our everyday lives.

Art...enhance fine motor skills, creative expression and crafts.

Music...appreciation for music through listening, singing, instruments & movement.

OCP is a Christian Preschool where Christian values will be shared and encouraged.

Completion of a registration form and receipt of a \$50 (\$35/additional child in family) non-refundable registration fee holds your position. (Fees and payments must be by check or cash.)

Additional Programs Available

Extended Day

For families who would like a longer day, children in 3 and 4 year old morning classes may for an additional monthly fee choose to extend their day until 3:00. Choose the days your child will attend on the registration form. Children will bring a packed lunch and snack. Quiet and active group experiences will be planned by qualified teachers. Naps will not be scheduled. A minimum of 8 students is required per day.

For Pre-K students:

- -Lunch Bunch—a chance to stay and have lunch with activities planned.
- -Discovery Days—an enrichment program that follows a theme. (some programs have been Legos, Pirates, Science.)

Must be 4 by August 1 \$215/month Tues-Wed-Thurs-Fri 9:00-11:30 Tues-Wed-Thurs-Fri 12:30-3:00

Must be 4 by August 1 \$240/month Mon-Tues-Wed-Thurs-Fri 9:00-11:30
