

First Christian Reformed Church-Crown Point COVID-19 Worship Plan

1. Safety of the congregation is our primary concern and we take this responsibility very seriously, so we ask for your patience as we navigate First CRC-Crown Point through this pandemic.
 - a. Anyone that may have reservations about attending or is experiencing COVID-19 or any sickness symptoms, please continue to watch the services via Livestream, Facebook, or YouTube.
 - b. Anyone 65 or over is strongly encouraged to stay home per the governor's plan.
 - c. Anyone working in health care is encouraged to stay home.
 - d. Families with young children are encouraged to stay home.
2. CPCRC will re-open our doors on May 17, 2020
 - a. Services will be at 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m.
 - i. 8:30 a.m. – Families with a last name that begins with letters A-J
 - ii. 10:30 a.m. – Families with a last name that begins with letters K-Z
 - b. Overflow
 - i. Wait for the next service or chairs will be provided in the foyer.
3. Council recommends that those attending worship put on a protective face covering before entering the building.
4. Usher Service
 - a. Maintain 6' social distancing while waiting to be escorted into church and the church sanctuary.
 - b. You will likely not get your "usual" pew so please be seated where the ushers place you.
 - c. Bulletins will not be available at the church.
5. Sanctuary Seating
 - a. Ushers will seat families together. Rear doors will be open 15 minutes prior to the service. Please sit in the pew location directed from the ushers.
 - b. Alternating pews will be used and alternating sides.
6. Coffee Service
 - a. Postponed until further notice.
7. Children's Programs
 - a. Postponed until further notice.
8. Nursery Service
 - a. Postponed until further notice.
9. Greeters and Welcome staff
 - a. A Council member will greet at the door with facial covering and sanitizer.
10. Restrooms
 - a. One set of restrooms will be open. Since bathrooms are less safe from contagion spread than other areas, please use only if necessary. There will be no access to mailboxes, the library, or classrooms.
11. Offering
 - a. Offering baskets will be placed on a table as you enter and leave church.
12. Cleaning and Sanitation
 - a. High traffic areas of the sanctuary will be sanitized prior to each service.
 - b. Hand sanitizer will be available at the welcome center and kitchenette.
13. Plan may change based on direction given from church Council and Governor Holcomb.
