As we GO... we Grow

"like a tree planted by water, which yields its fruit in its season and whose leaf does not wither."

January 2017. Most of the trees around us stand sleeping in the cold. Yet each week the Holy Spirit 100hr Community Challenge Tree continues to sprout new leaves. Even cherry blossoms are appearing.

It's not the will of man but the Spirit of God who challenges us to join Jesus and, by His power and strength, to lift our eyes - - get outside ourselves -- and GO. Doing good things *for* God is not the same as doing good things *with* Jesus. The first is often of the flesh; the second, the Spirit.

Have you noticed the birdcage with the open door and the bluebirds flying free? Here in the NW – and around the world -- Christian-centered teams like Shared Hope Int'I, Family Promise, IJM, World Vision and literally 1000s of others, by Jesus' grace and power, are opening cages and setting captives free. Forgiveness + being filled with His Spirit – spiritual freedom is the greatest freedom of all. Jesus cares about your body -- He cares even more for your soul.

Jesus describes the work of the Spirit to blind Nicodemous, saying: "The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear the sound, but you can't tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit." The specifics of how you respond to Jesus' call are between you and Him. Trinity is here to encourage, challenge and sometimes nudge you toward an option or two to prime the pump. "Encourage one another daily, as long as it is called 'Today' so none are hardened by sin's deceitfulness."

As the 100hr Community Challenge Tree grows each week **inside**, the reality represented by these leaves and cherry blossoms reflect things happening **outside** where people are hurting, struggling and yearning to know the true and living God. Jesus said to those who doubted: "My Father is working to this very day and I too am working." "The Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is something he sees the Father doing. Whatever the Father does, these things the Son also does." As we draw closer to God, the Spirit lays on our heart things God cares deeply about and calls us to Join Jesus on His mission -- each in our unique way -- yet often in teams. Each small leaf plays a small, yet significant, part in reflecting God's presence and healing touch in our hurting world.

If even, for just a short time, God were to withdraw His sustaining grace and power from our world, everything around us would soon look like Aleppo -- all that is good and beautiful blown to smithereens. Fortunately, we don't live in Aleppo. As we enter 2017, we still have time and opportunity to be a part of the healing work God is doing in our community. "As we GO, we GROW. As we GROW, we LEAF and BEAR FRUIT. As we bear fruit, we discover the sweetness of God's will and our Father in heaven is glorified.

Let's take the CrossRoads Journey together. Happy New Year 2017! Clint



News from Mrs. Wilson's Classes

Mrs. Wilson's classes began December by learning the month's Bible verse, "Glory to God in the highest!" from Luke 2:14. They heard the Bible story of Jesus's birth, and many other Christmas stories, some favorites being <u>Mortimer's Christmas Manger</u> and <u>Bear</u> <u>Stays up for Christmas</u> by Karma Wilson, and <u>Pete the</u> <u>Cat Saves Christmas</u> by Eric Litwin. The three-year-old class made special handprint ornaments to give to their families. The fours made pretty pine cone ornaments, and learned that we give gifts at Christmas to remember that God gave us Jesus, the best gift of all.

Both classes completed a unit on Creation, with the fours making a Days of Creation book to take home to keep. Letter-of-the-week studies for the fours included letter "I", in which students were able to study insects, build igloos, and experiment with ice, and letters J and K. The threes had fun with the book <u>Brown Bear, Brown</u> <u>Bear, What Do You See?</u> by Bill Martin, Jr. and Eric Carle, creating a puppet for each animal in the story.

Both classes worked hard learning lines and songs for an interactive retelling of the Christmas story to perform for family and friends, but sadly the program had to be rescheduled due to snowy weather conditions.

Classes ended the month with a chapel service, and Christmas parties where they had a chance to make sparkly snow globes, jingle bell necklaces, candy cane or manger scene ornaments, and play some fun games including making a "snowstorm" with a parachute. 2017



CHRISTMAS BASKET Ministry – THANK YOU!

The Christmas Basket Ministry of 2016 involved many volunteers, both members and non-members including our local Boy Scout troop! The generosity, strength and prayers of all who participated helped make this a welcome outreach into our community. You served 101 families – 96 from five local Hillsboro schools (directed by the school district, referrals from counselors), 2 from Family Promise and 3 referred from Trinity members.

These families of over 517 individuals included 330 children, infants through 18 years. Your outreach that began with a monthly donation of age/gender specific toys in February, "Gifts of Warmth" collection during Lent and a collection of food and toiletries throughout the Fall, provided food, household items, toiletries, quilted potholders and blankets, gloves, hats, scarves & some coats, Payless gift cards, grocery gift cards and a Bible for family Christmas celebrations as well as gifts for the children.
