

SPECIAL EMPHASIS CLUB

What It Is

The Special Emphasis Club is a fund-raising initiative. The funds raised via this initiative will be used to do ministry in the areas of Missions and Education. Fifty percent of the funds will be earmarked for Mission activities and fifty percent will be earmarked for Educational activities.

How The Funds Are To Be Used

The Director of Missions and staff will have the responsibility to design and lead mission activities (home and foreign) under the overall Convention theme: "Take the Pew to the People." The activities are to evolve around, and in promotion of, the overall and yearly themes of the Convention.

The Congress President and staff will have the responsibility to design educational curricula to meet the needs of member churches, districts and ministry leaders, including but not limited to: Youth Encampment, Oratorical Contests, and Congress classes. The activities are to evolve around, and in promotion of, the overall and yearly themes of the Convention.

Qualifications

To become a Special Emphasis Club member, an individual will pay \$10.00 per month (\$120.00 per year) AND make a commitment to continue paying into the fund at that rate for a minimum of four (4) years.

Recognition

Each member will be acknowledged after the first \$120.00 contribution and will be pinned with a pin designed especially for this initiative. (The purpose of wearing the pin will be to promote the club and its purpose.)
