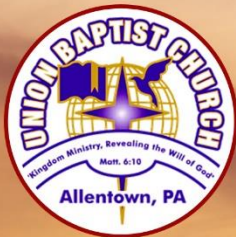

As the Academic Dean, you will spearhead the institute's academic vision, fostering an environment that nurtures intellectual growth, spiritual development, and ethical leadership among our students. Reporting directly to the President, the Academic Dean will work closely with the institution's leadership team to align the academic programs with the overall strategic goals of the B.T. The B.T. Hailey, Sr. Bible Institute Registrar is a crucial role responsible for overseeing the administrative operations of the institute. This position requires a dedicated individual with a strong background in records management, and a deep commitment to the institute's mission and values. The Registrar is responsible for maintaining student academic records, coordinating the registration process, managing course schedules, and ensuring the confidentiality, integrity and accuracy of all academic data. This role serves as a central point of contact for students, faculty, and administrators, providing guidance and support to ensure the smooth operation of the institute's academic programs. The Registrar reports directly to the Pastor, and Director. The Registrar works closely with the Academic Dean, the Students, the faculty, and other administrative staff to ensure the seamless coordination of all academic-related activities. The successful applicant should also possess a strong understanding of the institute's mission, values, and the unique needs of its student population.

SPECIFIC DUTIES, FUNCTIONS, AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Directs and coordinates UBC registration activities: Consults with Pastor and Director to devise registration schedules and procedures.
- Collaborate with administration, academic dean, faculty, media & technology to facilitate and improve services to students, including catalog and registration/records policy questions.
- Responsible for collecting, recording, maintaining and reporting of student records e.g., grades, registration data, transcripts, and other associated audits.
- Organizes and administer the records, registration and graduation functions, including transcript evaluations process in order to provide maximum service to students while ensuring efficient and effective workflow.
- Supervises the coordination, evaluation and certification of all graduation applications, while overseeing the complete graduation process to include all elements of the rehearsal and ceremony.
- Analyzes statistical data on registration for administrative use in formulating accurate contact information for official records.
- Prepares student rosters for faculty at least two weeks before class is scheduled.
- Ensures that faculty completes and submits attendance and grades in a timely manner upon completion of the class for a permanent record filing.
- Directs preparation of student transcripts and archive for UBC record keeping.
- Prepares commencement list for all satisfactory completers and submit list to Director for preparation of certificates for graduation.
- Directs preparation of statistical reports on educational activities for government and educational agencies and interprets registration policies to faculty and students.
- Directs compilation of information, such as class schedules and graduation requirements, for publication in school bulletins and catalogs.
- Coordinates dissemination of information on courses offered and procedures students are required to follow in order to obtain grade transcripts.
- Issues official transcripts.
- Coordinates class schedules with room assignments for optimum use of buildings and equipment.
- May assign rooms for student activities.
- Possess Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, proficiency in data analysis and reporting, and a commitment to providing exceptional customer service to students and faculty.
