Questions for Personal Reflection or Small Group Discussion

1. Did anyone come to mind as I asked if you had an Elizabeth?
What did you go to him/her for? Why did you go to them?
2. Has God ever led you to someone who you needed to help you sort out your life and God's will? How did that come about?
3. How prevalent are people like Elizabeth in our culture? What keeps us from having more like her? What's keeping us from being more like her?
4. What's the difference between actively looking for someone to mentor and waiting for God to send someone to you? Which approach are you more drawn to?
5. What two or three disciplines and routines could you put into your life – this Advent and beyond – to prepare for the arrival of someone who needs you to be their Elizabeth?
6. What does this passage have to say about being "Rooted in Jesus, Growing in His Love [Together], [and] Branching Out to Serve Others"?
