Questions for Personal Reflection or Small Group Discussion

1. What does 'being Biblical' mean to you? Have you ever been questioned for NOT being Biblical? Have you ever questioned someone else's commitment to scripture?
2. How do you think God's Word came to be? What difference might that make in how you read, understand, and do what it says? What does it mean for you that it is authoritative and inspired?
3. What scripture themes and threads (foci) do you tend to focus on? Ignore? Defend? Explain away?
4. If you had to pick, would you rather Understand what the Bible says without doing it or DO what the Bible says without understanding it, which would you choose? Why?
5. What could you do in 2021 to better understand and obey God's Word?
6. What do these passages have to say about being "Rooted in Jesus, Growing in His Love [Together], [and] Branching Out to Serve Others"?
