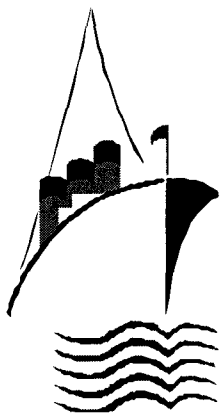


ALASKA CRUISE UPDATE

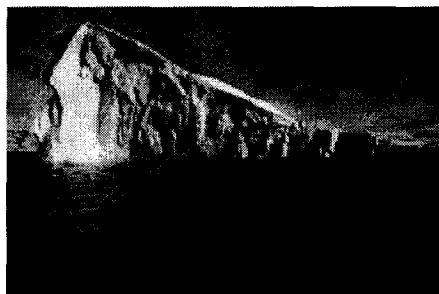

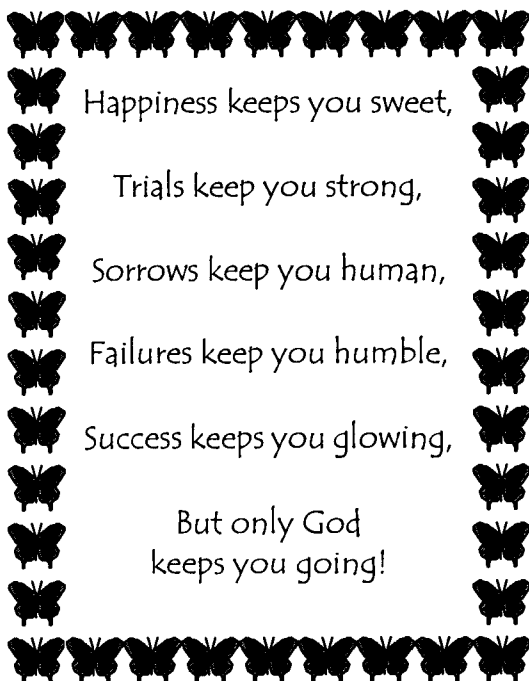

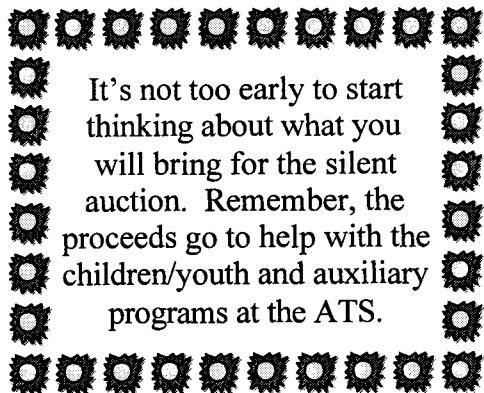
