He emphasizes Jesus' healing acts, probably because of his own background. Luke had an outstanding command of the Greek language. Luke is only named 3 times in Scripture. Luke was a well-educated, observant, well-spoken, and careful writer. So, what do we learn from his story? Well, though Luke had many attributes and successes, he remained humble, always focusing on the Ministry of Christ. How important it is for us to focus on Christ...and remain humble in our own journeys as well. Read Luke's Gospel and the Book of Acts in the New Testament...and never forget that we are AN **EXCITING CHURCH EXCITED ABOUT ITS MISSION!**


