In a continuation of what I started last week, here are the final 5 of “God’s 10 Most Wanted Men”: 6) The man who goes to church for Christ's sake, rather than for his own or someone else's, 7) The man who has more passion to help others than he has to be helped himself, 8) The man who can see his own faults before he sees the faults of others, 9) The man who stands firm in his convictions, based upon the Word of God, and is a "backbone"

Christian, and 10) The man who is more concerned about winning souls for Christ than he is about winning honor.

Finally, let’s talk about our Biblical Man of the Week. This week, we share a little bit about Luke. Luke is the author of one of the New Testament Gospels. He is also the author of the Book of Acts. Luke was a physician and the only Gentile to write any part of the New Testament. Luke was a close friend of Paul, who referred to him as “the beloved physician” (Colossians 4:14). He emphasizes Jesus’ healing acts, probably because of his own background. Luke had an outstanding command of the Greek language. Luke is only named 3 times in Scripture. Luke was a well-educated, observant, well-spoken, and careful writer. So, what do we learn from his story? Well, though Luke had many attributes and successes, he remained humble, always focusing on the Ministry of Christ. How important it is for us to focus on Christ...and remain humble in our own journeys as well. Read Luke’s Gospel and the Book of Acts in the New Testament...and never forget that we are AN EXCITING CHURCH EXCITED ABOUT ITS MISSION!

THE DEACON’S MESSAGE

Have you ever been hungry and not quite sure what to eat? There is nothing more frustrating than having breakfast, lunch or dinner, and a few moments later still being hungry. 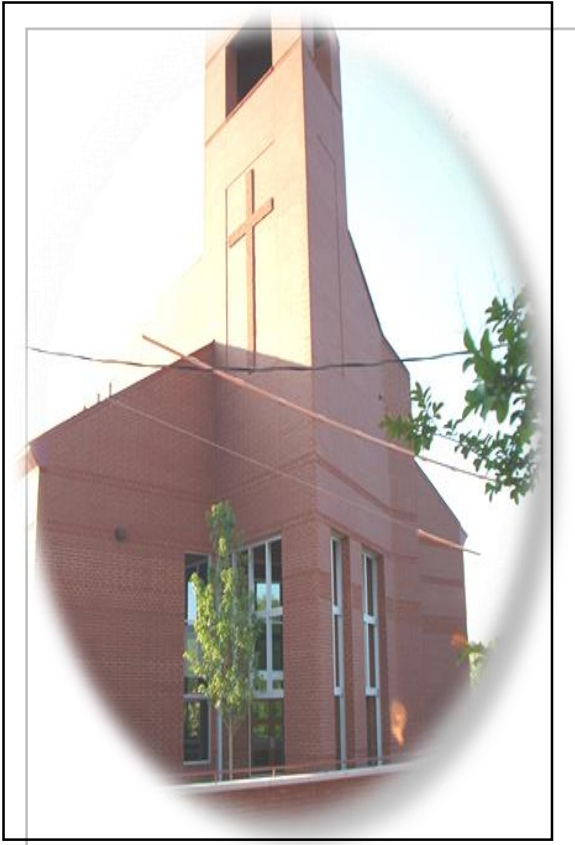
