Covid 19 Vaccine

If this vaccine is based on a piece of RNA from the virus itself, how do we know it's not going to harm us?

The mRNA vaccines (Pfizer and Moderna) are not using part of the virus itself. They are using scientifically engineered mRNA, which our bodies are well equipped to recognize and decode, that encodes only for the spike protein on the virus. So this is not a live viral vaccine or an attenuated virus vaccine. It allows our immune system to develop immunity to the virus without ever being exposed to the virus. Since mRNA is natural to our bodies, our body naturally degrades the mRNA, so it does not last very long in our body, but it is there long enough for our body to develop immune recognition and memory, so that if our body ever sees the real virus, it knows how to fight it.

How do we know the COVID-19 vaccine is safe?

The FDA is responsible for making sure that, just like any other medications, any FDA-authorized or approved COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective. Developers are required to go through a rigorous, multi-stage process including large (phase III) trials that involve tens of thousands of people participating. After the clinical trials show that the vaccine is safe and effective, a series of independent reviews and evidence is required to demonstrate efficacy and safety.

If I had COVID-19 and recovered, should I get the vaccine?

Yes. Currently, there are not enough data to say if or for how long after infection someone is protected from getting COVID-19 again. Early findings suggest natural immunity from COVID-19 may not last very long, but more studies are needed.

How many doses will I need?

Most of the COVID-19 vaccines currently in phase III clinical trials in the U.S. require two consecutive doses, three or four weeks apart. Other COVID-19 vaccines in development may use one dose. Pfizer's vaccine requires two doses of the vaccine 21 days apart. Moderna's second dose is administered one month after the first.

Could I have an adverse reaction or side effects from the vaccine?

There is a potential for injection site reactions (redness, swelling, and pain) as well as fever, fatigue, headache, chills, vomiting, diarrhea, muscle pain, and/or joint pain. These are common adverse reactions seen with other vaccines. Even if you experience common side effects from the vaccine, it is still necessary to receive the second dose for the vaccine to be effective.

If I get the vaccine, do I still need to wear a mask and practice social

distancing?

Yes. Vaccines may boost your immune system so it is ready to fight the virus if you are exposed, but it is not yet fully understood whether vaccinated people might still be able to transmit the virus. Wearing a mask and following other precautions such as social distancing and frequently washing your hands will help reduce your chance of being exposed to and spreading the virus.

VARIANTS OF CONCERN

DELTA VIRUS:

First identified in India

SPREAD: Spreads more easily than other variants.

SEVERE ILLNESS AND DEATH: May cause more severe cases than the other variants.

VACCINES: Breakthrough infections in people who are fully vaccinated are expected, but vaccines are effective at preventing severe illness, hospitalizations, and death. Early evidence suggests that fully vaccinated people who become infected with the Delta variant can spread the virus to others. All FDA-approved or authorized vaccines are effective against severe illness, hospitalizations, and death.

OMICRON-B.1.1.529

First identified in South Africa

SPREAD: May spread more easily than other variants, including Delta

SEVERE ILLNESS AND DEATH: Due to the small number of cases, the current severity of illness and death associated with this variant is unclear.

VACCINE: Breakthrough infections in people who are fully vaccinated are expected, but vaccines are effective at preventing severe illness, hospitalizations, and death. Early evidence suggests that fully vaccinated people who become infected with the Omicron variant can spread the virus to others. All FDA-approved or authorized vaccines are effective against severe illness, hospitalizations, and death.

COVID VACCINE UPDATES FOR 2022

MASK: CDC recommends using N95 or KN95 Mask. Cloth mask are not effective against the virus; however, they are better than no mask. The mask must cover the Nose and Mouth completely. The mask must fit snuggly to avoid the virus from seeping into the nostrils. Change mask frequently.

TESTING: Covid Virus is spreading rapidly therefore numerous test sites are needed. Some sites require appointments and others don't. The rapid test is better. It takes 24 to 48 hours to get results. Home test give quick results but gives false results if not done properly. Beginning January 19,2022 Free at Home Covid-19 test will be available. They are available to every home in the U.S. Each home is allotted 4 free test and there is no shipping cost. You don't need to Enter a credit card number.

NUMBER OF CASES: Covid is growing rapidly. Today's numbers increase by the thousands each week. Infants and toddlers are affected. This population is not able to get a vaccination.

VACCINATIONS: Children ages Syrs to 12yrs are now eligible to receive 3 Covid vaccinations and a booster. Adults need a booster. If you received the J&J vaccine (one-shot) you need a Pfizer or Moderna booster. The one-shot vaccine does not provide the best protection.
