PASTOR-ELECT MARC A. LAVARIN

Pastor-Elect Marc Antoine Lavarin most recently served as an Assistant Minister at the historic Alfred Street Baptist Church in Alexandria, VA, under the leadership of the Rev. Dr. Howard-John Wesley. **He is the Pastor-Elect of First Calvary Baptist Church in Durham, NC.**

As a proud Bostonian, Pastor-Elect Lavarin completed his undergraduate studies at Northeastern University, graduating cum laude with a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science, concentrating in Public Policy and Administration.

Upon graduating, he was selected to be a part of Teach for America's Massachusetts cohort, where he taught 5th and 6th grade History. While teaching, Pastor-Elect Lavarin earned his Master of Education degree from Boston University. After two years of teaching, Pastor-Elect Lavarin submitted to the call of ministry by completing his Master of Divinity degree at Duke University. At Duke, Pastor-Elect Lavarin received the Martin Luther King Jr. scholarship, granted to incoming students committed to the work of social justice.

Upon the completion of his degree, Pastor-Elect Lavarin was ordained at the Evangelical First Haitian Baptist Church of Worcester, Massachusetts, under the direction of his father, Rev. Antoine Lavarin. Currently, Pastor-Elect Lavarin is pursuing a Doctorate of Ministry degree in Educational Leadership from Virginia Theological Seminary concentrating on the influence of the Black Church on K-12 education. Pastor-Elect Lavarin is a published author, with his newest book chapter contribution "Let the Schoolhouse Say Amen: The Pedagogical Congruency Between the Black Church and Critical Literacy", set to be published by Information Age Publishing Company. Pastor-Elect Lavarin's passion lies at the intersection of faith, education, and policy, where he hopes to inspire communities to be moral and ethical agents of change.

Pastor-Elect Lavarin is married to his best friend, Barbara Lavarin, who hails from Brooklyn, NY and is an ordained minister and gifted poet. Together they hope to inspire communities and people to discover their potential and purpose!

A LITANY FOR THE LORD'S SUPPER

I Corinthians 11:23-34 (NRSV)

Leader: For I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when He was betrayed took a loaf of bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

People: In the same way he took the cup also, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes.

<u>Leader:</u> Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be answerable for the body and blood of the Lord. Examine yourselves, and only then eat of the bread and drink of the cup.

<u>People:</u> For all who eat and drink without discerning the body, eat and drink judgment against themselves. For this reason many of you are weak and ill, and some have died.

<u>Leader:</u> But if we judged ourselves, we would not be judged. But when we are judged by the Lord, we are disciplined so that we may not be condemned along with the world. So then, my brothers and sisters, when you come together to eat, wait for one another.

<u>All:</u> If you are hungry, eat at home, so that when you come together, it will not be for your condemnation. About the other things I will give instructions when I come.
