



Reflections from the Pew: the Ministry of Pastor Fredrick A. Davis

One of the greatest differences that I have noticed about First Calvary since Pastor Davis has been here is the increased opportunities for children to be included in the life of the church. They are recognized for their achievements both inside and outside of the church. They are highly respected and not seen as the church of tomorrow, but as an essential part of the church of today. Some of the ministries developed for children under Pastor Davis' tenure include Children's Church, MLK Youth Lock-in, an increased emphasis on the nursery, Children's Bible Study, dance and mime.

When Pastor Davis came onboard here, I was hoping that as the new pastor he would have pastoral care as a priority. Pastor Davis has more than delivered on this. He is always accessible and available when there are needs or concerns in the lives of members of the church or community. His care and concern reached beyond the walls of the church as he travels out of town to attend the funerals of relatives of members. He opens up the church to families seeking a place to funeralize their loved ones. He is genuinely empathetic. I have often seen him shed a tear when death or other tragedies come into the lives of others.

The male Summit has had a significant impact on the culture of FCBC. Its existence is an indication that the church views the leadership and the participation of the male population an important component of who we are. In the past, in most Baptist churches, women ran the show. Today at First Calvary, men are expected to work alongside the women. men are observed serving in areas where they were not serving in before and contributing exponentially. First Calvary has become a church where everyone has a part to play, is expected to play that part, and is given the opportunity to do so.



Reflections: A Conversation with Pastor Fredrick Amos Davis

Q: As a retiring pastor, what will you miss the most about the day-to-day responsibilities?

A: Pastoral care, counseling, and visitation.

Q: What will you miss the least about the day-to-day responsibilities?

A: Administration

Q: Do you have a bucket-list of things you want to do now that you have retired? If so, what are the top three things on your list and what do you plan to tackle first?

A: (1) Finding a time and place to take a vacation. Going out of the country, and I have to get my passport renewed. (2) I pretty much have a confirmation that I'm going to run for county commissioner in 2024. And just see how that goes.

(3) Try to find major funding for the Westend Community Foundation Inc. to enhance and strengthen the facility.

Q: Knowing what you know now about pastoring a church, what is the most important piece of advice you would offer a young you?

A: Pastor, take more care of yourself and family. Keep an emphasis of honesty to the people in every aspect, in leadership, finances...just stay honest with the people.

Q: Other than the Holy Bible, has any other book influenced your life and ministry?

A: Several books in terms of church leadership. All of the leadership books written by my late classmate, Dr. George McCalep: Huddle in the House, Sin in the House. Faith Raising vs Fund Raising was a key book in helping me understand the finances of the church. John Maxwell - leadership. I used to totally engage, but I haven't lately, in the Howard Thurman writings. I used to be a work-study person in the Howard Thurman Institute, yeas ago at the ITC, so in my storage I've got old Howard Thurman tapes. Jesus and the Disinherited, and then the audio conversations that I get from my wife of the books that she reads.

Q: Do you plan to continue to preach in retirement?

A: I'm sure I'll be extended invitations. As a matter of fact, I've turned down another three more this week because I didn't want to do anything until after December. I did make a commitment to one of our sons of the church, Gary Brown, so I'll be preaching his 10th Pastoral Appreciation service, but other than that I have not committed to anything until after December. I've already been offered, even back in January, when that interview with WTVD aired, a church in Timberlake, NC, asked me to come be their interim pastor. I said no, I'm still on the payroll at First Calvary:—) I'll probably preach some, but not much. Maybe probably more out of town than in-town. Next August, I've got to go to Mobile, AL to preach for a friend, so I already have some lined up for next year.

Toni: I would imagine after a lengthy career, you'd need a break.

Pastor Davis: it's been a great time not having to prepare for Bible Study, and of course, I was a part of Sunday School preparation for the Couples Class, and then sermon preparation, but it was comfortable for me because I had a discipline pattern of when I knew I had to start and finish. And then you all helped in Video, for Hilary on Wednesdays and you on Thursdays.

Q: What would you characterize as your biggest accomplishment as a pastor?

A: Moving the church beyond the walls of the church by establishing the nonprofit organization, at the time called Calvary Ministries of the Westend Community, which is now the Westend Community Foundation, Inc. and going through the process of the nonprofit having gained ownership of the property for \$25 of the facility and the success of campaigning in the 1996 bond referendum for the 6.4 million dollars for the renovation of the Community Family Life and Recreation Center. That's major. In the height of the recession, we built this church. We started in 2008, and in January, 2010 we were in here!

Q: What do you see as your greatest failure as a pastor?

A: Not being strong enough in administration. Developing some type of initiative for better volunteers. We didn't have that, and we still don't have that. It might not be a failure of mine...but I see it as mine. What I always wanted to guard against from my first church pastoring was making sure there was an atmosphere of being welcome to do ministry in the church...welcome to be a part of the church.

Q: What will you miss the most about pastoring and preaching at FCBC?

A: Interacting with the people.

Q: Do you plan to affiliate with another church, or keep your membership/discipleship at FCBC?

A: The interesting thing...technically, I don't have membership here. By being the pastor, I became a part but I didn't technically join First Calvary. My family did. Right now, we are praying on where we go but it looks like I'll still be here. I'm still with the American Baptist Churches of the South. I serve as the minister to the American Baptist USA, so I have to be a part of an American Baptist Church wherever I go.

Q: What advice or words of wisdom would you like to leave to the congregants of FCBC?

A: Keep loving God and keep being an exciting church excited about its mission. And make the missional effort continuing to be about evangelism, enhancing, and empowering the people and discipleship. Discipleship is still the key. Dr. Forbes brought that here. He said it's not about membership; not about maintenance...it's about discipleship.

Q: What are Abraham Asaad's plans now that you are retiring?

A: I have plans of going into the studio pretty soon. Don't know quite yet when. Still working on studio time.

Q: Is there anything you want to specifically stay to the Calvary Chronicle Staff?

A: Thank you for your commitment and your service in keeping the congregation edified.


