Quid Pro Quo, it means to substitute or one thing in return for another. Maybe you worked extra hours last week and because of that you were paid overtime. At times, having a substitute is wonderful and other times things are not necessarily equal in the exchange. A perfect example is found in Isaiah 53:5 (NKJV). It says, "But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by his stripes we are healed." I cannot fathom the love it required for God to make such an exchange. He substituted our sins for his sorrow, our unrighteousness for His Son's righteousness, and our lives for the death of His Son. When you look at yourself in the mirror every morning remember your life for Christ's death was not an equal exchange... yet, God felt you were worth it. That is reason enough to praise Him today.

The Parenting Tip

A GOOD FAMILY RESOLUTION: LISTENING TO GOD MORE Seven questions to help us respond

Listening to God is a skill that Christians should hope to make a lifetime habit. As we're listening for and hearing God's voice, ask this follow-up question: *How are we responding*?

To help with the response, here's a list of seven questions, one for each day of the week. Try keeping this list somewhere that everyone can see, like on the refrigerator or near the dinner table. Tackle these questions together as a family. You can use these simple conversation starters to help your own family take responsibility for what God is telling you.

Sunday: What did you hear from God or learn about God at church today? Monday: What Scripture verse did God impress on your heart today — and how did it affect a choice you made? Tuesday: Share something you saw or did today that brought God to mind. Wednesday: What do you think God is teaching us as a family — and why do you think that? Thursday: How have you seen God doing a good work in a family member's life? Share a story about your observations. Friday: Share a way in which you are struggling. How can you seek God's help in this area? Saturday: What is one thing you learned about God this week? Explain how you learned it.

If you miss a day, no worries — you'll have an opportunity to tackle it next week. The goal is to look to God for direction in daily life and respond to His leading, helping one another along the way.
