The Beyond COVID Committee met to discuss the recent easing of restrictions in the new Emergency Orders 2020-29 issued by the City and County of Honolulu. Whereas many of the guidelines we are following are unaffected, there is one significant change for small group gatherings which should be seen as an opportunity to rejoice: Groups of five or less people are allowed to meet together. Based on this new guideline we are opening the out-of-doors areas on our campus to groups of five or less people effective immediately (i.e., the Palm Court and the Lanai). The indoor areas will remain closed to ensure a safe workplace for our staff and financial officers who are essential for our operations. And because of our preschool we will keep the campus shuttered during their hours of operation.
