Hebrews 4:12

The uniqueness of the bible has three fundamentals:

Revelation

Inspiration

Authority

Revelation

Derived from the Latin noun meaning unveiling. It indicates that God has taken the initiative to make Himself known.

Job 11:7-9

Inspiration

God has revealed himself partly by nature and supremely in Christ, but also speaking to particular people.

II Timothy 2:16-17

Authority

The power or weight Scripture possesses because of what it is, namely, a divine revelation given by divine inspiration.

Luke 5:4-5

Authority

God discloses what would be otherwise unknown;
he uncovers what would be otherwise be hidden.

Deuteronomy 29:29

Galatians 1:12

Ephesians 3:3

It is by revelation, inspiration and authority that God makes himself known
