

Music time:

Music time is the first thing we do when the kids arrive and the pastors do a great job of getting them moving and singing!

Snack time:

We serve a variety of foods for snack time. Snack is served after opening music time and before we begin the rotation into story, craft and game. Please let us know of any food allergies by filling out the WOW registration form.

Bible story time:

We share the Bible story in a very visual and engaging way by using vibrant felt boards. The detail is amazing and the children have the opportunity to participate in the sharing of these stories.

Craft time:

Our craft projects are either connected to the Bible story or our Christian faith.

Game time:

We choose active games. Sometimes the games are related to the story for the day and other times they are kid favorites. Whatever the game, we aim to get them moving!

Prayer time:

To wrap up our WOW session, we gather together and close in prayer.

Optional Children's Choir:

What is WOW?

WOW is an after school program for grades 1-5 held on Wednesdays. All children in the community are welcome. Kindergarten students can attend if they have an older sibling attending and the parents feel their kindergartner is ready for this experience. WOW includes snacks, music, games, Bible stories, prayer, and crafts.

WOW is in place to help children further develop and deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ, strengthen their faith, and encourage them to share that faith in Jesus with others. The WOW program is a safe, encouraging, positive place for elementary children to be Wednesdays after school.

Transportation:

Free bussing is available for Central Elementary students.

Students who go to other schools are encouraged to attend WOW, but need to work out their own transportation.

Absences:

When the WOW bus arrives we take attendance to make sure we have everyone. Therefore, ***we need parents to contact All Saints if their child will be absent from WOW***, just as they would contact the school to report an absence.
