Join us for the annual All Saints Fish Fry in the fellowship hall. All food is provided, a free will donation will be collected.



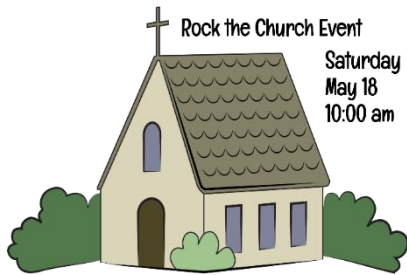
Carnations for Mother's Day
