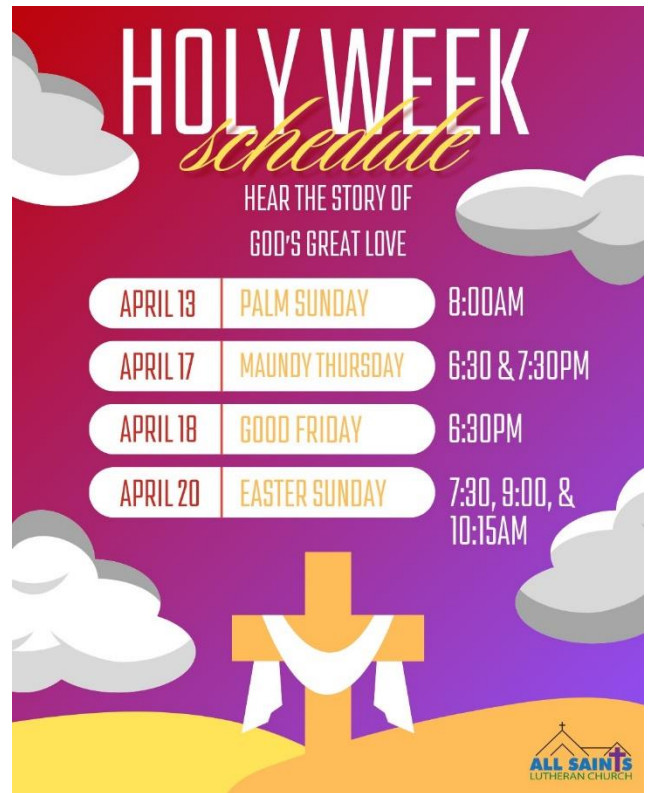




E-Note for April 16, 2025
