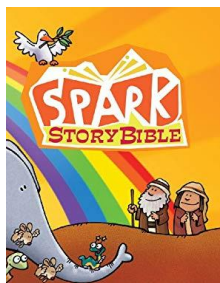


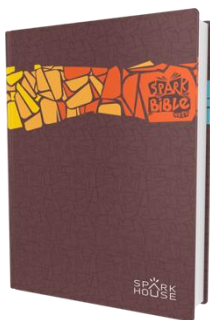
Bibles:

In our S.S. classrooms, we use the “Spark Story Bible” for Age 3-Grade 2 and the “NRSV Spark Bible” for Grades 3-5. (The Spark NRSV bible is also used by our Confirmation youth Grades 6 – 8). We encourage children to bring their Bibles with them to S.S. to follow along during story time. There are Bibles in each classroom that can be used by students as well. Every year, 3rd Grade parents purchase a 3rd Grade Bible and that will be the NRSV Spark Bible.
