Resolution Supports Nigerian Brethren Invites worldwide community of Brethren to a week of fasting and prayer

Annual Conference delegates voted Saturday in favor of a resolution indicating solidarity with Ekklesiyar Yan'uwa a Nigeria (EYN, the Church of the Brethren in Nigeria). Among other things, it commits to *a week of fasting and prayer on Aug.* 17-24, and invites the worldwide community of the Brethren to join in that commitment.
