## **Emergency Financial Aid for Nigerian Church**

At their fall meeting, the Church of the Brethren Mission and Ministry Board approved up to \$1.5 million to begin funding an emergency response fund to the church in Nigeria. An allocation of \$500,000 from the Emergency Disaster Fund was approved. The board also decided to commit \$500,000.00 from reserves and up to another amount of \$500,000 from reserves as a matching challenge to donors. The Southern Ohio District Board has approved a donation of \$10,000.00 from District reserves (recently increased through receipt of some assets fromt he recently closed Poplar Grove congregation) to the Nigeria Crisis Fund which will be matched by an amount set aside by the Mission and Ministry Board of the Church of the Brethren. <u>The Board is asking congregations and district individuals to</u> <u>consider gifts to this special fund as well.</u> More information about EYN (the Church of the Brethren in Nigeria), including how this money will be used can be found at the denominational website (brethren.org).

### **Disaster Ministry Updates**

2014 in Review--As we reflect on 2014, it stands out as a very busy year for S. Ohio BDM. We sent fourteen crews, totaling 159 volunteers to New Jersey for Superstorm Sandy recovery. They worked at rehabbing houses in Spotswood, and both rehabbing and working on new builds at Toms River. The expenses of these trips were covered by S. Ohio BDM through funds raised at the annual Ice Cream Social and donations from congregations, individuals, and businesses. There was no monetary cost to the volunteers who served. Working with Church World Service, we sent 40 Baby Kits, 75 Baby Blankets, 425 Hygiene Kits, 504 Clean up Buckets, and 643 School Kits.

Together as a district, we have shared God's love and made a difference in the life of disaster survivors. All are welcome to join in this ministry. Monthly meetings are usually the first Thursday of the month at Mill Ridge Village Community Center, 1000 Mill Ridge Circle, Union, OH 45322. Fellowship time is at 6:30 P.M. and the meeting begins at 7:00 P.M. Our January meeting is on the second Thursday, Jan.8, due to the holiday. Thank you to all for supporting S. Ohio BDM.

*Volunteers Needed: Crews of 26--*Brethren Disaster Ministries continues to work in New Jersey with Superstorm Sandy recovery. It's over two years now since the disaster, and many are still in need of housing.Thank you to those who responded for the **December 7 - 13 trip. We sent seven** volunteers to join workers from other districts. We now need volunteers for our regularly scheduled trips of **February 15-21 and March 15-21.** There is much to be done with the Sept. 1 deadline for completion of twelve houses in Toms River. To meet this need, a second house is being opened for lodging volunteers, and our crew size is being increased from fifteen to twenty-six. We need many
