What's That You Say?

Have you ever said something and then wish you hadn't? I have. Sometimes my thoughts are moving so fast that my mouth can't keep up and then something comes out that either doesn't make sense or is not what I intended to say. Other times my attitude gets in the way. If I don't keep a check on my attitude, things eventually come out of my mouth that I regret.

The children of Israel had that problem. During their time in the wilderness, they complained frequently about their food and water and various other things. When they finally came to the border of the land promised to them by God, instead of believing the land was theirs and taking it, they sent in 12 men to spy out the land.

Only two of those men, Caleb and Joshua, came back with a good report. The other ten spoke words that showed the condition of their hearts. Rather than believing what God had told them, they only believed what they saw with their *natural* eyes: **WALLED**

CITIES AND GIANTS! OH, MY!

-Then -

"...all the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, and the whole congregation said to them, "If only we had died in the land of Egypt! Or if only we had died in this wilderness! "Why has the LORD brought us to this land to fall by the sword, that our wives and children should become victims? Would it not be better for us to return to Egypt?" -Numbers 14:2-3

The true condition of their hearts came out of their mouths. They did not believe what God had told them! And God let them have what they wanted. In the end, that is how it works. We do get to choose.

"Say to them, 'As I live,' says the LORD, 'just as you have spoken in My hearing, so I will do to you: 'The carcasses of you who have complained against Me shall fall in this wilderness, all of you who were numbered, according to your entire number, from twenty years old and above.

Except for Caleb... and Joshua..., you shall by no means enter the land which I swore I would make you dwell in. But your little ones, whom you said would be victims, I will bring in, and they shall know the land which you have despised. But as for you, your carcasses shall fall in this wilderness." -Num. 14:28-32

This account stops me cold and makes me think. The words of my mouth also reveal the condition of **my** heart. Do my words line up with God's Word? Or do my words reject and oppose the truth of God's Word? Just as our actions reveal our faith or lack of faith in God, so do our words.

Jesus said, "But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart..." Paul tells us this: "It is written: 'I believed; therefore I have spoken.' Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak." 2 Corinthians 4:13

The word of God makes it clear that believing and proclaiming are vitally linked. If we really believe something, we *will* proclaim it. God's word also tells us that faith comes by hearing the word of God. If we refuse to hear God's word (His promises), faith will not be established in us. That is why the people of God were given the commission to proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ, so that faith would come by hearing and those who heard may be saved.

What are your words revealing about you and what you believe? Have you given the word of God a *chance* to establish faith in you? Or are you afraid of it? Those who are sincerely seeking truth have nothing to fear! Our God is merciful and not willing that any should be separated from him, but we must accept his offer; we *must make a choice*.

The Bible is filled with promises for those who believe in Jesus. Following is a list of just a few of them. What if we began proclaiming these promises, instead of speaking about the circumstances we see with our natural eyes? Our ears would then hear and faith would be established in us! Others will hear and faith may be established in them! God help us hear your words and speak them.


