Sermon: "What Did You Expect?"

Scripture: Luke 9:51-62

Synopsis: In this week's passage, Luke says Jesus "set his face to go to Jerusalem." Luke is giving us more than a travel itinerary. He's telling us something about the meaning of Jesus' life. In a sense, Jesus was born to go to Jerusalem. In Jerusalem, Jesus will accomplish his most holy work. Luke says along the way some volunteered to follow him. Jesus counters their speak-easy will to follow with some tough demands. We can only imagine that some would-be followers, perhaps even some of us, are unprepared for the rigor of the journey. But then, having learned at the feet of Jesus, having known his priorities, what did we expect?
