



DAVE RAMSEY'S FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY PROGRAM

THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Sunday, February 23, 2014

Sermon: "A Godly King and Two Boneheads"

Scripture: 2 Samuel 2: 1-14, selected

Synopsis: This is a story told with a long sigh. After a decade of having been hunted down in the wilderness, living on the defensive, David is now in a position of power as Israel's newly anointed king. David, a man after God's heart, is in a position to advance God's holy purposes. And he will. But no sooner does he enjoy his moment of victory than the two sons of Zeruiah, Abner and Joab, begin causing trouble by instigating a series of military games, stirring up old wounds between supporters of David and Saul. Their egotistical games produce a civil war. Now David's golden opportunity to set a new agenda is mired in the misguided interests of two boneheaded generals. It shouldn't be this way. But the long story of God's salvation history suggests that it almost always is: God's Kingdom purposes get worked out in the context of lesser purposes. As Eugene Peterson writes, the good news embedded in this story is that "the sons of Zeruiah {and all generations of their aliases} are accounted for in God's economy, and that however difficult they make the life of faith in Jesus, they can't destroy it." (**Leap Over a Wall**, 124-25).
