

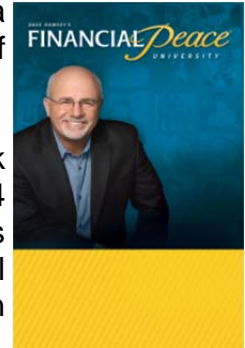

WELCOME

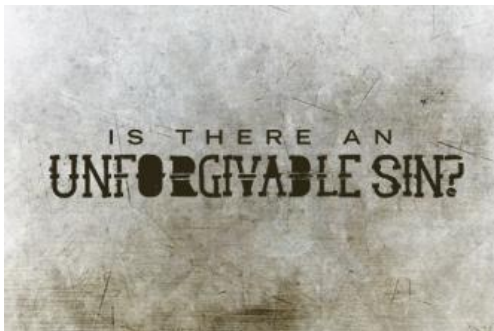
