The Death Of Many Someones

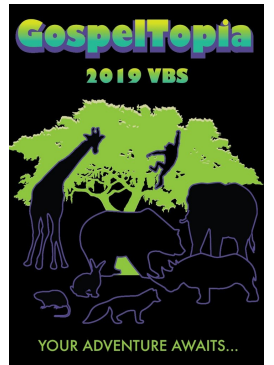
It's Not Too Late!


