PSC Mobile Unit Making an Impact

One exciting advance is the addition of coaches in the Abilene area for clients from the mobile unit. These clients have the opportunity to be connected to a coach through the Dickinson County Life Center (DCLC). Abilene area churches are partnering to connect clients to coaches, churches, and material assistance. It's been great to see the people of Dickinson County rally together to help others!

Recently a client's mother stopped by the mobile to say thank you! Her daughter and boyfriend were coached by a couple of the DCLC. The mother shared that the coaches made a great impact on the young couple, especially the boyfriend as he heard from another man.

Group classes address three main topics: parenting, relationships, and childbirth. Volunteer teachers spend time getting to know the class participants and often connect in such a way that the relationship doesn't end when class ends.

John and Evelyn Hyde teach our Love and Respect class that helps couples work through conflict resolution from a Biblical perspective. After clients complete the class they receive a date night package of dinner and a movie. A graduating couple texted: "What a great gift! We will definitely take advantage of this date night package soon. Thanks so very much."
